## Recent open doors:

The Lord recently blessed our family with the privilege of helping host a visiting missions group of over forty people. Greater Portland Baptist Church has been an immense blessing and long-time supporter of my parents, the Tate family, and ourselves. The main emphasis of the trip was to inundate the local schools with outreach efforts and materials, including teaching, preaching, and hosting multiple VBS rallies. Including preaching via interpreter in the Sunday and Wednesday services, this church group was able to teach over eighty times throughout the short week that they were here, with over one hundred fifty decisions of salvation made. They were an added blessing to our family personally as they helped in various projects across the property, including a very experienced carpenter from their group taking his time to teach us how to build cabinets for the facility.

In addition, we are so excited to announce the arrival of my mother, seasoned missionary to Honduras for over two decades. For the past four years, she has been living with a friend in the Texas area and ministering in a local Baptist church, while we sold our house, completed deputation, shipped our belongings, and began construction on these two staff cabins. Due to lack of residency, she will be compelled to leave the country every three months for at least a week, but as far as we can see, she will be living with us from now on. She has already been a blessing to the church family here in numerous ways, not to mention the huge encouragement and asset she has been to us personally.

## Upcoming projects/events:

My oldest son and I have been invited to drive to Nicaragua at the beginning of October for a 3-day conference to teach on the subject of a Biblical Philosophy of Music. We count this a great privilege and are very thankful as God continues to open up new doors of opportunity for our family, but are equally excited for the ongoing ministries He has already given to us. As Dakota and myself have been teaching every week at the Presidential Guard, we are encouraged to see more and more of a positive response to the Word of God. And as always, we are continuing on-going construction and various development across the facility.

## Prayer requests:

- We ask for prayers concerning my mother's health and safety. She is very prone to heat stroke and sensitive to the intense hot and humid weather that is quite common to experience in the area where we live. Though she is somewhat limited in other ministry capacities, please pray that the Lord shows her precisely His will for her during this time.
- We ask for continued prayers that the Lord, in His grace and faithfulness, provides the needed materials and support to further develop this property.
- We ask for specific prayer towards this upcoming Nicaraguan trip, that the Lord gives us safety through travel and He makes clear to us exactly what He desires us to teach in this conference.
